Your local church news will help acquaint our regional membership with each other. Please share something with us that is going on at your local church so we can share it with the region.



(Excerpts from message by Jack C. Decker to the 60<sup>th</sup> General Assembly in 1965)

We know the Church as the Body of Christ. We can find a multitude of Scriptures that would declare that this is the Church, but what is it really like to the people on the outside of the Church? To those five hundred million Catholics, who are we? To us we are just as glorious as can be, clear as the sun, terrible as the army, but to them, who are we? (He read Proverbs 29:18 and Hosea 4:6 and continued) We are wasting time for the lack of knowledge. We are allowing millions of people to be destroyed without having knowledge of us. Who is accountable? Who will have them on their hands at judgment?

I can't get away from this command to go and teach all nations. These are things that are our job to do. My people are destroyed for the lack of knowledge. April 3, 1920, our former General Overseer put a piece in a periodical at that time, "I wonder if the moving picture machine will not be wrenched from the devil some time and be put into use to help us spread the gospel. What would be more impressive than the incident of the crucifixion and the resurrection thrown on the screen with an appropriate message on the subject?' That was his vision forty-five years ago. (98 years ago now in 2018)

The magnitude of our work as a church is too great for our small membership to accomplish. Every hour we are going further behind. Did you know that in the fifteen minutes that I have been here twelve hundred souls have gone into eternity? Not only that, but there is another side to this. In that same time over one thousand souls have been added to live here on this earth and die as most of their ancestors without hearing our message. (What would these statistics be now in 2018?) We only have one hope—the power of God and mass communication. There isn't one individual minister who is here today that can reach all these people, even by preaching every night and two or three times a day. God is giving man more and more knowledge. His interest is in the Church and not in the world. God must be allowing all these inventions to be invented for us. I don't believe He is allowing this to happen to see if one nation can outdo another or so communism can outdo us or so Catholicism can outdo us. These inventions are made for us. People are dying waiting for us.

**Editor's Note:** There is much more that we can do than what was done 98 years ago. Social media can be used as a tool to advance the gospel along with our verbal witness and the printed page. Are we doing our part today? We can still give someone a tract, call someone, invite someone to church, etc. God is counting on us. He has instructed this message into our hands. What an awesome responsibility resting upon us.

**Ministry** 

Ronald and Donielle Legg Pastor at Castalia, Ohio

I grew up in the Castalia, Ohio area. I was not raised in the Church. I was raised Baptist. I was raised to know the need of salvation, and I remember when I was 13 years old, I had three cousins killed in a car wreck and an aunt die within 3 day of each other. We were on our way to my aunt's funeral when I was talking to my parents, telling them I had been asking the Lord to forgive me, and I did not feel that he had yet. It was there in the backseat of a car that I gave my heart to the Lord. While I wish I could say I have never backslid and have continuously served the Lord from that moment, I cannot say that.

I started to become aquainted with the Church when I started dating my wife, Donielle, back in the Church of God of Prophecy days. I remember when I first started visiting, the Holy Ghost fell in one service, and they were speaking in tongues and shouting. I went home and told my parents, "I think those people have lost their minds." While I said that out of ignorance and not knowing the truth, I continued to visit on and off and never really applied myself to learn the full truth. Even after Donielle and I were married, I would visit from time to time but never gave one thought about maybe they taught the real truth. Donielle and I were married on April 24, 1993. For those of you that know your history, it was the day before the Holy Ghost gave the third message at the South Cleveland church. I remember a man by the name of Brother Cooper. He was always so kind to me when I would visit and would talk to me just as if I was a member there. He became very sick with cancer, and Donielle's mother and grandmother were going to visit him in the hospital. I told Donielle that I wanted to go also. I remember him telling the ladies in the hospital room, "keep your eyes on that 'concerned group.' They are the ones keeping the truth." I did not even know what that meant, but it stuck with me.

In 1995, Donielle's father had gotten me a job where he worked. I watched his life and the respect that those he worked with had for him. One Sunday morning, Donielle and I went to visit the church in Fremont, Ohio. The pastor announced that Donielle's father was going to speak that night, which peaked my interest. I told Donielle that I wanted to go back that night to hear what he had to say. Well, I was shocked. While I thought I had him fooled that I was saved, he called me out and said that he wanted to see the Lord save me. The Lord used this to show me I

wasn't fooling anyone. I gave my heart back to the Lord that night, and I can say that I have not looked back from that night. The Lord saved, sanctified me and filled me with the Holy Ghost within a few months of each other, and I joined the Church after much prayer and fasting. A few months later, the Lord called me to preach in a Sunday morning service. I continued to work in the factory with Brother Bolyard, growing in the Lord and learning all I could about the Church.

The Lord blessed a group of us from the local church to go to BTI in 1998. In December of 1999, I was on the job working, and the Lord spoke to me and said, "I have called you to do my work, not to sit in this factory." The next few weeks were rough. I couldn't pray. Every time I went to pray, the Lord would say to me, "submit to my government." I finally called Brother Bill J. White, my Regional Overseer, and told him I would go wherever he needed me. In June of 2000 he asked me to take a church in Portage, Indiana. In 2002, Brother Ard, appointed me to Mansfield, Ohio. I Pastored there for 3 years. In 2005, I was appointed to Castalia, Ohio where I am currently serving as Pastor. In 2016, I was ordained as a Bishop at the General Assembly.




## High–Principled Teens Needed!
