If God has called you to be really like Jesus, He will draw you into a life of crucifixion and humility and put upon you demands of obedience. You will not be able to follow other people or measure yourself by other Christians, for in many ways He will seem to let other good people do things which He will not let you do. Other Christians and ministers, who seem very religious and useful, may push themselves, pull strings, and work schemes to carry out their plans, but you cannot do it. If you attempt it, you will meet with such failure and rebuke from the Lord as to make you penitent.

Others may boast of themselves, of their work, of their successes, of their writings; but the Holy Spirit will not allow you to do any such thing. If you begin it, He will lead you into some deep mortification that will make you despise yourself and all your good works.

Others may succeed in earning money, or may have legacies left to them; but it is likely God will keep you poor because He wants you to have something far better than gold—namely, a helpless dependence upon Him so that He may have the privilege of supplying your needs from an unseen treasury day by day.

The Lord may let others be honored and noticed, but keep you hidden in obscurity because He wants to produce some choice, fragrant fruit for His coming glory which can be produced only in the shade. He may let others be great, but keep you small. He may let others do a work for Him and get credit for it; but He will make you work and toil, without your knowing how much you are doing. Then to make your work still more precious, He may let others get credit for the work you have done, thus making your reward ten times greater when Jesus comes.

The Holy Spirit will put a strict watch over you, with a jealous love, and will rebuke you for little words and feelings, or for wasting time, things over which other Christians never seem distressed. So make up your mind that God is an omnipotent sovereign and has a right to do as He pleases with His own. He may not explain to you a thousand things which puzzle your reason in His dealings with you; but if you absolutely give yourself to Him, He will wrap you up in a jealous love and bestow upon you many blessings which come only to those who are in the inner circle.

Settle it forever, then, that you are to deal directly with the Holy Spirit and that He is to have the privilege of tying your tongue, chaining your hand, or closing your eyes in ways that He does not seem to use with others. Now, when you are so possessed with the living God that you are, in your secret heart, pleased and delighted over this peculiar, personal, private, jealous guardianship and management of the Holy Spirit over your life, you will have found the entrance to heaven.



From the desk of the Regional Overseer

James T. Smith



The theme of our recent regional convention was "Pressing Toward the Mark" taken from Philippians 3:14 "I <u>press</u> toward the <u>mark</u> for the <u>prize</u> of the <u>high</u> <u>calling</u> of God in Christ Jesus."

In particular, the Church has a two-fold high calling that she must reach: (1) what She is to become—Ephesians 5:27, and (2) what she must do—Matthew 28:19-20.

"That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having <u>spot</u>, or <u>wrinkle</u>, or any <u>such thing</u>; but that it should be <u>holy</u> and <u>without blemish</u>" (Eph. 5:27).

"(19) Go ye therefore, and <u>teach all nations</u>, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: (20) Teaching them to <u>observe</u> <u>all things</u> whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen." (Matt. 28:19-20).

I believe we understand our ultimate goal as typified (characterized) by the above scriptures. They clearly define the life we should seek to live, and the work to which our lives should be dedicated to completing. We must never lose sight of this ultimate high calling that the Lord has given us.

What we often have trouble with is understanding how this long term high calling affects the choices we make and the actions we follow each and every day. EVERY day should begin with our seeking Him to guide us in just exactly how TODAY we are to "press toward the mark" of this high calling. We find in the scripture a great set of principles that we should follow. We have captured many of these in the Church's Prominent Teachings and in our Advice to Members. We would be well advised to put these into operation in our daily lives.

The high calling describes where we are headed, but it does not describe how we are to accomplish this high calling. If we are to achieve this high calling, there are <u>specific steps</u> that the Lord would have <u>each</u> of us to walk before Him.

The Lord, beyond these principles by which everyone should live, also provides specific guidance for each (individual) life, for each (specific) day of one's life. This principle is described by David in **Psalms 37:23** "The steps of a good man are <u>ordered</u> by the LORD: and he delighteth in his way." According to <u>Albert Barnes' Notes on the Bible</u>, the word rendered here as "ordered" means to stand erect; to set up; to found; to adjust, fit, direct. The idea being conveyed here is, that <u>all</u> which pertains to the journey of a good man through life is <u>directed</u>, <u>ordered</u>, <u>fitted</u>, or <u>arranged</u> by the Lord. That is, <u>his course of life is under divine</u> guidance and control.

"...that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life" (John 3:16).

A Lifeboat is a specially constructed (established) boat launched from land to rescue people in distress at sea. Many are headed into a storm. Many are in a storm or coming out of a storm. In which ever case, there is still a rescue that is needed.


There are many today that need to be rescued from these storms of violent disturbances.

When To Preach

An old-time English bishop sent for John Berridge to reprove him for preaching at all hours and on all days. "My lord," said he modestly, "I preach only at two times."

"Which are these, Mr Berridge?" "In season and out of season, my lord."

I can think of several examples we can draw from Scripture that should help make this principle of personal divine guidance and direction for each step we would take each day. In Acts 8:4-8 we find the account of Phillip's evangelizing in Samaria. This was the Church's first major outreach beyond Jerusalem and Judea. This new outreach was motivated by the persecution led by Saul who "made havock of the church." Thus, what was intended for evil proved to be for good. Phillip's outreach was prepared by the greatest of all evangelist, Jesus Christ when He made that stop in Samaria in John 4. Thus Phillip found a people ready to receive the Good News (Gospel)!

Phillip's presence in Samaria was surely the result of his following the Spirit's unction and direction. Yet in the midst of this great revival, the Lord interceded with other plans for Phillip. In Acts 8:26 an "angel of the Lord spake unto Philip, saying, Arise, and go toward the south unto the way that goeth down from Jerusalem unto Gaza, which is desert."

Do you suppose Phillip wondered at the Lord pulling him out of a great revival to go into a place that was essentially barren (of people), a desert? Yet Phillip was obedient to this specific direction from the Lord. He had not been told why he was being sent or what he should expect, but simply "GO!"

Having arrived in Gaza, further instructions were given when "the Spirit said unto Philip, Go near, and join thyself to this chariot." Only after approaching the parked chariot did the first indication of what awaited him was revealed: "Philip ran thither to him, and heard him read the prophet Esaias."

So, we find Phillip being pulled by the Lord's direction from a mighty revival among the Samaritans to go minister to a single person in the middle of the desert. Why would the Lord direct such strange behavior? (Or was it?)

Looking back on this account, I can see two points that could justify such unexpected direction from the Lord. First, the Samaritans were now well on their way to embracing the Gospel, many of them having received the Holy Ghost (Acts 8:17). On the other hand, this Ethiopian eunuch was on his way home to Ethiopia and would soon be out of contact with the message of Jesus Christ. The time for the Church to act to reach him with the Gospel was NOW!

Although the eunuch had in his possession a copy of the book of Isaiah, he was not understanding the significance of what he was reading. When asked if he understood what he read his response was "How can I, except some man should guide me?" Because we understand the Word of God it is easy to assume everyone else should as easily be able to understand. But do they? Paul explains the need for each one of us to fulfill our roles as ambassadors of Christ:

"For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. (14) How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher? (15) And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!" (Rom. 10:13-15).

Who but the Lord could have known that Phillip's witnessing to this single Ethiopian would become the vanguard of much of Africa being evangelized with the Gospel! This event is clearly an example of why we should follow His guidance and direction every day—even when it doesn't fit the pattern of how we think we should proceed.

But this was the exception to the rule, wasn't it? Does the Lord actually direct us to specific situations? Consider what happened to Phillip after baptizing this now recently converted Ethiopian eunuch:

"And when they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing" (Acts 8:39).

Some have speculated that Phillip literally flew through the air. I do not know about that. Perhaps the greater meaning we should gather here is that Phillip's current yielding to the Lord's direction and guidance regarding this eunuch resulted in the Lord's pleasure in him!

Recall our earlier Scripture regarding the Lord's response to those who accept His "ordering" of their walk before the Lord. Psalms 37:23 concludes with "he delighteth in his way." Perhaps Philip's being "caught away in the Spirit" signifies the Lord's pleasure in how obediently Phillip had followed the Lord's "ordering" and was rewarded with that next assignment the Lord had for his faithful servant!

Shouldn't we all want to walk such an "ordered" life before our Lord and Savior?



Photos From The Past





Levi was saved April 11th, 1999 at 17 years old after nearly committing suicide. It was in a COGOP he was saved. His grandma attended there so he went there also. He was called to preach that June in a youth camp.

Realizing the let down of the standard, on January 16th 2003 he moved to Virginia to try to learn under another COGOP minister who claimed to hold on to the doctrine. He was hungry for God to move in his life and ministry.

February, 5th 2003 he was electrocuted by power lines on a construction job. He had already gotten saved, sanctified, filled with the Holy Ghost, and now this was the next best thing to happen in his life. Levi says "I've never doubted this was the will of God because a few days prior, we were having a baptism service and God spoke to me at the end to get baptized again, to be a witness that He was going to do something in my life" (and that service was videotaped to look back on).

His time in Virginia allowed him to come in contact with The Church of God which he joined June 26th, 2006 in the VA/WV convention.

In the fall of 2008 Levi and I met, and on June 13th, 2009 we were married by my dad in Alaska, where we lived until 2011. We then moved to Willard, Ohio where we live now and attend The Church of God in Castalia, Ohio. I was raised in The Church of God my whole life in a pastor's home.

While I was growing up my parents pastored in Minnesota, Wisconsin, and Alaska. I wish I could say, that I had stayed faithful my whole life. I'm so thankful though, for the of love God that never stopped trying to reach me. The love is still drawing me closer and closer each day.

As you know we have been blessed with 3 children; Noah Allen (9), Selah Lynn (7), and Benjamin Ezekiel (6), who we are in the process of adopting.

the Bible is right. A lot of people who call themselves the Church of God are due to have a hard time. Why did the rooster crow after Simon denied our Christ? 
Are you aspiring to greatness? Do you have your eye on a high office in the Church? If so, what's your "platform"? How about letting the Bible outline it for you?

"Let us walk by the same rule, Let us mind the same thing"

"Endeavoring to keep the unity of the spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body, and one spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one Faith, one Baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all" (Eph. 4:3-6).

As long as there was only one church, there was little need to have to identify the congregation of God that existed in the world. When heresies began to creep into the Church and factions arose, however, it became apparent that some identifying marks of the Church be recognized to separate the true church from the counterfeits. As each faction arose and split off of the main branch, the claim of having the true gospel was usually made to substantiate their title of being the continuation of the early Church.

While the desire to identify the true Church was already conscious in the Church of the first century, the need for marking the Church became more and more apparent with the arrival of new heresy and faction. By 187 A. D. Irenaeus listed some twenty varieties of Christianity. By 304. A. D., the number of factions, the forerunner of modern denominationalism, had grown to eighty. In fact, it was said by Celsus, the antichristian philosopher of the second century, that the Christians were "split up into ever so many factions, each individual desiring to have his own party."

In the present world of denominationalism, the marks of the true Church* become more important than ever before in the history of the Church. The Scriptures teach only one doctrine, one Lord, one baptism, and one Church for all. By being able to identify the marks of the true Church, the congregation of God in the New Testament can not only be recognized, but a better understanding can be ascertained of what constitutes the Church of God. Some of the marks of the true Church are: (1) the true preaching of the Word; (2) the right administration of the sacraments; (3) the faithful exercise of discipline; (4) the staunch reality of unity; (5) the actual fulfillment of prophecy.

Excerpts from message by L. S. Rhodes to the 38th General Assembly in 1943

[Editors Note: The following message was preached nineteen days before the death of A. J. Tomlinson.]
